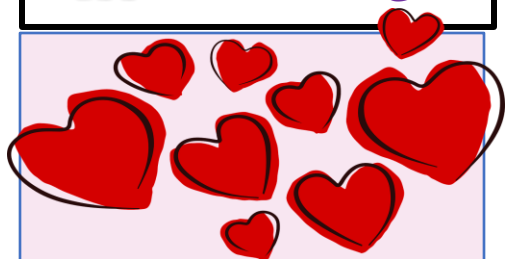

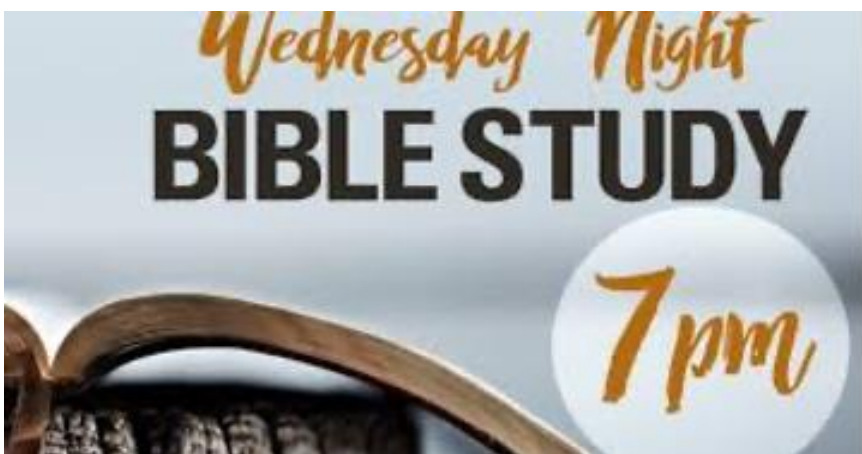

Devotion

The Truth About Righteousness

February 2025

John 16:10

John 16:5-7 says Jesus is going to His Father and it's to our advantage He did. If He didn't go, the Helper wouldn't come to us! He said if I go, I will send Him as promised in Luke 11:13 and John 14:16-19. He'll ask the Father, and He'll give us the Helper to be with us forever. He's the Truth, abiding in us forever, and because He lives we will live also! Rom. 8:8-11 says, without the Spirit of Christ in us, we don't have God. Our body's dead, due to sin, yet a believer's spirit is alive since Christ's righteousness is in us per 1 Cor. 1:20-31 And He will raise us from the dead just as He did Jesus! John 16:8-10 says He'll convict us regarding righteousness since He's going back to the Father and we'll no longer see Him (as our role model on earth). He knew the "world" would teach that we must be "like" Him, asking "what would Jesus do" when we're tempted to sin. Some look for His "image" in one of us to model the life that gains Heaven's Glory. He's telling us, no chance, because there's never been anyone since Adam and Eve to meet God's standard of perfect righteousness. And there won't be, again, until He returns to earth at the beginning of the thousand year millenium per Revelation 20:1-4.

We're subject to God's Word. It demands we choose between our works of righteousness, or the Gift of God's Righteousness, which comes thru faith in the work of Jesus to save us. Read Luke 18:9-14, where Jesus told a parable to ones who trust that THEY are righteous. Here a Pharisee bragged about his goodness and scorned a tax collector who beat his chest and begged mercy for his sins. Jesus said this man went home justified, meaning declared righteous by God. Also, read Matthew 7:13-14 as Jesus declared (ending His Mount Sermon) for us to enter thru the narrow gate. The gate's wide and the way broad that leads to destruction, where many go, but few find the narrow gate! John 10:1-10 says Jesus IS the narrow gate. And none come to God but thru Him (John 14:6). Thieves and robbers try by self works. They rob God of His Grace and steal His Glory. Jesus said He came to give His Life abundantly in John 10:10, and eternity is certainly sufficient! Vs's. 27-30 say to His sheep (who hear and follow Him) I give eternal life, and no one can snatch them from My or My Father's hands- and Weare One!

Matthew 7:21-23 confronts proud folks trying to enter wide "gates", saying, only those who do the will of My Father will enter. He said in John 6:40 "this IS the will of My Father, all who behold and believe in His Son WILL have Eternal Life." Many will declare their good works done in His name, and He will say "I never knew you. Depart from Me, you who practice law- lessness." Lawlessness, here, is practicing faith in Moses Law of death, as 2 Corinthians 3:4-17 explains. Romans 3:19-27 reveals that, apart from the Law, God's saving righteousness is a gift of His Grace, thru faith in the redeeming blood of Jesus. It frees us from the law of death, to receive the law of Life, in Jesus, so no one can boast. Rom. 3:31 thru 4:8 reveals that Abraham and David learned of God's Law of faith, in their day, and we're to re-establish it in our hearts. Israel foolishly traded it for the Laws of Moses after they left Egypt. Carefully, read 1 John 1:3-7 and rejoice. When we receive the "LIGHT" of God's Truth- we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus, God's Son, cleanses us from ALL sin. Vs's 8-10 invites all to confess that we're sinners, and be cleansed forever, also! Denying this truth is calling God a liar. That's none of us- I pray. All for the glory of God's Trinity.

Jesus: The LORD of ALL Accept NO Substitutes!

Colossians 2:6-10 - ⁶ And now, just as you accepted Christ Jesus as your Lord, you must continue to follow him. ⁷ Let your roots grow down into him, and let your lives be built on him. Then your faith will grow strong in the truth you were taught, and you will overflow with thankfulness. ⁸ Don't let anyone capture you with empty philosophies and high-sounding nonsense that come from human thinking and from the spiritual powers of this world, rather than from Christ. ⁹ For in Christ lives all the fullness of God in a human body. ¹⁰ So you also are complete through your union with Christ, who is the head over every ruler and authority.

If you have ever experienced ordering online at Walmart and arrive at the grocery pick-up area, you have likely also been asked if you are willing to accept some substitutes for items that were out of stock or couldn't be located. Usually, because of the hassle involved of trying to have my bill modified or having to actually go inside to look for the item myself or risk going without the similar product, I will just accept the substitute. Often times the substitute is a higher quality brand or larger quantity than I had originally ordered anyway. So, I am usually ok with the substitution.

However, we live in a world that seems to be constantly trying to substitute the Truth of Jesus Christ as the LORD of all things created, visible and invisible, natural and spiritual, temporal and eternal with something lesser. The NLT translation of this text states these "empty philosophies and high-sounding nonsense" try to "capture" us. Not only are we being challenged by human thinking but also attacks from the spiritual realm to accept these lies. There are so many false prophets, incorrect teachings, blasphemies, and humanistic theology being substituted as Christianity.

As believers, we must solidly be able to rightly divide scripture and discern the truth. We also must be willing to help others not to be deceived, by sharing the Truth. As 2 Timothy 4:3 warns, "a time is coming when people will no longer listen to sound and wholesome teaching...they will follow their own desires and will look for teachers who will tell them whatever their itching ears want to hear...they will reject the truth and chase after myths".

As followers of the Way, we must strive to put on the full armor of God each and every day (Ephesians 6:10-18) be rooted in and abiding in the Vine that is Jesus Christ (John 15) and share the Gospel with a hurting world.

Jesus Christ is the LORD of ALL! Accept no substitutes!
