Devotion

How Important That God Forgave <u>All</u> Our Sin Debt?

John Chapter 13 & 1 John 1:7

The Good Samaritan parable shows I can't meet its requirements & Matt. 18:24 proves I can't buy salvation. Psalm 19:12 says I can't discern my sins, let alone confess them. Jesus said in John 13:8-10 we can't have <u>any part with Him without a complete</u> bath. He said He's God, in John 10:27-30, and Heb. 6:18 says it's impossible for Him to lie. He promised in Mark 3:28-29 that all sins are forgiven but one. <u>It's</u> unbelief in Him, to have provided <u>Eternal</u> Redemption for sins per Hebrews 9:12; 28 and 10:10-29. Rom. 3:19-25 says God reckons us righteous when we place faith in Jesus' blood. Rom.5:10 & 17 says by reconciling to God by His death, we're saved by His Life. We aren't "unreconciled" when we sin again, since He promises eternal intercession for believers in Heb.7:24-25. Heb. 6:11-20 says He's the anchor that gives sure hope for eternal redemption. He demonstrated in Luke 22:32 & Matt. 11:2-11 that He intervened to perfect the faith He authored (Heb 12:2) to Peter and John the Baptist!

He rose after His last supper in John 13:1, viewing His departing this world. Having loved His own, He wants to show believers how He loves us to the end! It was the eve before the Passover Feast. The next day He would die the death that validated the new covenant in His blood that took away man's sin penalty forever per Hebrews 9:16 to 10:10-17. Matthew 26:26-28 reveals the men eating and Jesus serving bread and wine representing His blood of the covenant that He would pour out for the forgiveness of sins. He began washing and drying their feet, saying you don't understand, but the washing I do now means nothing, until you see that the blood I will shed tomorrow is for the eternal cleansing of the world's sins. You, who see, will no longer walk in the "dark" regarding My work of redemption. We're to see thru the eyes of His imputed Life, that gives "light" (John 1:4 and 1John 1:7), that His blood is washing our steps clean daily until we stand before Him sharing His Glory by Grace! The deceived who think they're not sinners (I John 1:8 and 10) are calling God a liar and the Truth (Jesus) is not in them. His Grace is for them also, if they see and confess their need for His redeeming blood (Vs.1:9) Then we're all cleansed into fellowship, as one, with joy complete per 1 John 1:3-4!

Jesus told Peter, in John 13:8, he could have <u>no</u> part with Him if he refused foot washing. John 13:10 (via John 15:3) says we're clean (bathed) by believing the word He spoke in Matthew 26:28. Yet we need the daily foot washing by His blood to be completely clean (for the rest of our earth life) as in 1 John 1:7 There we see the light" of what Jesus' blood is doing.! Peter said in John 13:37 that he would lay down his life for Jesus (the greatest love "service" <u>anyone can do per John 15 12-17</u>) to have part with Him. In Vs. 13:38, Jesus shows Peter how soon he would need His "foot washing!" John 13:10 means when we first trust we've been washed of past sins by His blood- we <u>must</u> continue to walk daily, by faith, that His blood is cleansing every sin we step in, on our journey to eternity with Him. Col. 2:6 says: "Just as you received Jesus (by faith) so walk in Him!

John 13:12 pointed to this. When leaving home daily, it's inevitable our feet will pick up worldly sins. Vs. 13:14 says to learn from our teacher, whose blood redeemed us from all our sins as Ephesians 4:31-32 confirms. We're to be kind with forgiving hearts, as His, without grieving the Holy Spirit who sealed us for the day of redemption (by His foot washing). In Vs.27 of Matt. 18:21-35 Jesus words draw us to Matt. 5:22 where He said a single sin, as small as name calling, will condemn us to hell if we choose Moses Law over God's Gift of Grace thru Jesus' blood. Matt. 5:29-30 adds (in effect) we'd have to amputate every body part that could conceivably cause our babies to sin the moment they're born. John 13:20 says "Truly, truly, I say to you, He who receives whomever I send receives Me; and he who receives Me, receives Him who sent Me. What a privilege to be sent by the Son of God with news that's too good to resist.



God will never give us more than we can handle, isn't that right, Jesus?




The verse you're thinking of is often misquoted, Lisa. God will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear.

Jesus: The LORD of ALL Accept NO Substitutes!

Colossians 2:6-10 - NLT

And now, just as you accepted Christ Jesus as your Lord, you must continue to follow Him. ⁷ Let your roots grow down into Him, and let your lives be built on Him. Then your faith will grow strong in the truth you were taught, and you will overflow with thankfulness. ⁸ Don't let anyone capture you with empty philosophies and high-sounding nonsense that come from human thinking and from the spiritual powers of this world, rather than from Christ. ⁹ For in Christ lives all the fullness of God in a human body. ¹⁰ So you also are complete through your union with Christ, who is the head over every ruler and authority.

There are so many things that compete for our attention each and every day. There is "stuff", and there are activities, hobbies, and even people that, if we are not careful, we can fixate on and devote much of out time, treasure and talents towards. But as believers in Christ, we must not be mesmerized by the "shiny objects" of this life and this world. Our gaze should be fixed on Christ alone. This verse reminds us that our daily walk should be one that is constantly progressing towards and with Jesus. WARNING! Here come s a profound statement: becoming a follower of the Way, requires "following"! It is not a one and done event. We must "continue to follow Him" in our obedience to His commandments, in response to His callings on our lives, and by engaging in His commission to "go make disciples" and "go be witnesses". We must abide in and "grow" in our relationship with Yeshua, for apart from Him we can do nothing Scripture tells us. We have to be willing to "permit" our lives to "be built on Him". He does not force our hand in the construction of our lives on the Cornerstone. We must choose whether we are more interested in following the sandy land of idols that the world cares about and the fulfillment of the lust of the wyes, the lust of the flesh, and the pride of life, or upon the Rock of our Salvation. We must reject the "empty philosophies", "high-sounding nonsense" that idolatrous human thinking and from the spiritual powers we wrestle against tempt us with. It is only in Christ that we will ever be complete. Accept NO cheap temporary substitutes of this life. Follow Jesus: the eternal LORD of all.
