Want to Be a Lost or Found Sheep? May 2025



Jesus' parable in Luke 15:1-7 says if God has 100 sheep on earth that He already sees in Heaven (Eph. 2:6), and one strays, won't He leave the 99 and seek the stray until He finds it!

When He <u>has</u> found it, He promises to lay it on His shoulders, rejoicing! Back home He calls angel friends to rejoice with Him for finding <u>My</u> lost sheep! The same way, there'll be more joy in Heaven for one who strays, than over 99 who also stand on <u>His</u> righteousness, and need no repentance per Heb. 9:12 and 9:28.

He likened it to a woman losing one of her 10 coins. She will light a lamp and search until she finds it. To enhance His point, He told a story of a man with 2 sons. The younger asked for his share of the estate. The Father honored his free will to receive it. See Romans 8:18-21. The son departed on a journey that led him to a life of total depravity, far removed from the life that God desires for us. His famine (lack) of holiness, that resulted from loose living, led him to seek counsel from one of their citizens. He led his depraved appetite deeper, to the point he was eating slop with the swine and longing for anything better, until he came to his senses.

He realized His Father's servants had more than enough bread for life, than they needed, while he was dying due to his lack thereof. He got up and headed for his father, ready to do business as Jeremiah 29:13 calls us to do. "You will seek me and find me when you search for Me with <u>all your heart</u>." He was prepared to say "Father, I've sinned against Heaven, and in your sight: I'm no longer worthy to be called your <u>son</u>; make me a hired man.

While still far away, his Father saw him and eagerly ran to embrace and kiss him. He quickly confessed his filthy life. His Father called His slaves to bring the best robe to remind him of his righteousness in Jesus to place on Him, a ring on his hand to remind him of His groom, in Christ, and sandals on his feet to keep him clean from every sin he would step in again as 1 John 1:7 reveals. He ordered the fattened calf, to kill and eat in celebration of the Great Supper to come. For this son of mine was dead and came to life again; he was lost and has been found, just like the lost sheep and the lost coin!

Want to be a lost, or found sheep? Which is secure? Neither, if we're not in Jesus' hands! Luke 15:4 implies that the 99 are lost if the 1 isn't found. Nine coins are useless if 10 are required for salvation under Law, since it's demands are precise. All are lost the first time we make a bad choice under it. Romans 5:10 says it puts us at enmity with God, since we can't meet His Perfect standard of holiness! Only Jesus could, and He did, in order that the blessing of Abraham's imputed righteousness can be gifted to us, by faith, so we can now receive the Promised Holy Spirit as Galatians 3:14 explains. Rom. 5:10 says we can reconcile to God by faith in the death of His Son, and much more, we're then saved by His Life, by receiving it per John 5:40. God promises us Eternal Life, with He and His Son who took the penalty for all our prodigal deeds, by His death on the cross. At His last supper in John 17:1-3 He said to know Him and the Father is eternal Life. He went on to pray for the disciples, and all who will believe in Him thru their word, to be kept from the evil one when they wander. Hebrews 6:13-20 and 7:24-25 explains this. Please read these Hebrew verses as the anchor for our souls!





Are you a nurse or do you know a nurse? If so, I have something I would like to share with you. I'm a volunteer with the Westmoreland Nurse Honor Guard. The Nurse Honor Guard is a volunteer organization that pays tribute to nurses who have passed away by performing a ceremonial service at their funeral or memorial. We have several ceremonies that we perform which include:

Nightingale Tribute: A specific ceremony that acknowledges the nurse's years of service and their dedication to others.

Nightingale Lamp: A lit Nightingale lamp is carried and then extinguished and presented to the family with personal condolences.

Roll Call: The nurse's name is called three times, with a triangle rung after each call.

White Rose: A white rose is often presented to symbolize honor and appreciation.

Members of the Honor Guard wear traditional white nursing uniforms, including caps and capes, as a nod to the nurses of the 1800s who tended to those on the battlefield. The ceremonies are a beautiful way to remember nurses who have passed on.
