The Cart Before the Horse

June 2025

1 Corinthians 15:1-6

We teach how to live the life <u>before</u> becoming Christians. Some say we're born again through water baptism, claiming that Acts 2:38 assures us that before we die, we <u>will</u> receive the Holy Spirit. Some say tithe, pray, read the Bible more and attend church until God judges us worthy. Or folks meet Jesus by watching the way we love and enjoy life. Confess our sins daily and say the Lord's Prayer before we fall asleep. Some keep Moses 10 Laws, or at least the 2 greatest ones, which fulfill the 10. <u>None</u> of these tell us when we "arrive." Only Christianity offers salvation as a free Gift of God's Grace- and we can receive it today, per 2 Corinthians 5:17-6:2!

Jesus, the Word of God per John 1:14, had John write 1:17 saying the Law was given thru Moses; Grace and Truth were realized thru Jesus. Verse 18 says He, coming from God, <u>explains</u> God to us. So, if Jesus brought Truth, there is a deceptive lie about the Perfect Law of Moses that Satan sells the world. Read 2 Corinthians 2:14 to 4:4 to get the picture. It says thanks to God who <u>always</u> leads us in triumph <u>in Christ</u>, and manifests thru us the sweet aroma of the knowledge of <u>Him</u> in every place, so we can be a fragrance of Christ, to God, among those being saved and those perishing; to the one an aroma from death (in this life) to the second death of Rev. 20:14, the other an aroma of life to life, as in John 11:25-26!

2 Cor. Ch. 3 says the Law on stone is a letter that ministers death to souls trying to meet it's demands; the Spirit of Christ gives Life to believers. The commands represent God's Perfect Holiness, thus guaranteeing hell for all seeking Heaven by them, since they can't provide proof on judgment day that they are literally as holy as God! Satan uses Proverbs 14:12 to deceive us. It says there's a way that seems right to man, but it's the way of death. Our inborn nature says the world doesn't give us a free ride, we must work for what we get. So, we struggle to meet the Law's impossible demands, and Satan encourages us to try a little harder, or just "do the best we can." 2 Cor. 3:14-17 says he keeps a veil over our hearts and eyes until we finally turn to Christ for <u>freedom</u> from the Law. And Romans 7:1-4 says we're now free to marry Jesus! His death and resurrection validated the New Covenant per Hebrews 9:15-17 to make this possible!

The Word of Truth says (Ephesians 1:13-14) we're included in Christ after listening to the message of Truth, the Gospel of our salvation- having also believed, we're sealed in Him with the Holy Spirit of Promise (of John 14:16-19) given as assurance of our inheritance, in view of our final redemption God's own possession (Heb. 9:27-28) to the praise of His glory. 1 Cor. 15:1-6 says the Gospel is Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures (Mark 3:28), was buried, and raised on the third day, and appeared to more than 500 believers at one time. John 1:11-13 says He came to His own, and they did not receive Him. Those who did, He gave the right to become children of God. Jesus had Paul write in Acts 13:38-41 that thru His death, we are freed from all things from which we could not be freed thru Moses Law. We can heed or perish. Romans 5:10 assures that when we reconcile to God thru the death of His Son, we'll be saved by His Life! See the Light and choose Jesus' pure blood to cleanse us (1 John 1:7) or our filthy rags that can never mop up all our unrighteousness. For HIS Glory.


