#### We'll All Face God's Red Sea

SEPT. 2025

EXODUS 14:13-30 -15:1-3

1 Peter 1:1-13 says Prophets of old searched to know the time and persons that the Spirit of Christ intended to hear what they wrote. It reveals they were serving us. Thru them, we see the price Israel still pays for rebelling against nearly all God asks! Three covenants assure our salvation. The Passover of Exodus 12:14 and 12:21-24 is the first. It called for Israel to rest (trust) in the death angel to "pass over" her children, which she did. The second is Exodus 31:12-16's promise, so God will prove in the end, that it's HE who sanctifies us (by Jesus' blood in Hebrews 10:10-17). He's been our Sabbath Rest for salvation since the creation.

Ezekiel chapter 32 speaks to Abraham's covenant of circumcision, the third statute. Here he rants against the nations who don't have circumcised hearts- and Israel is the worst! We're to circumcise <u>any</u> assumptions in our hearts that God will accept <u>any</u> help in His plan of salvation. The first time, Abe and Sarah used Hagar, to "help a little," rather than resting in God's Divine intervention to create life in her barren womb. Today we're to trust that the child born of Mary 2,000 years ago by immaculate conception was a gift from God, sent to redeem us from all our unrighteousness so we can have Eternal Life. Jeremiah 17:19-27 says trying to enter "New Jerusalem's" judgment gate, without complete Sabbath Rest, offers nothing but a kindled fire!

Like us, Israel largely ignored God's promise to rest in Jesus until there's no "way out." Her greatest crisis, on the way to the Promised Land, was crossing the Red Sea. Exodus 14:13-30 to 15:1-3 paints the picture. Pharoah's army charged to annihilate them when they didn't follow the "finger" that moved the cloud that morning. Chaos reigned until Jesus' "finger" intervened to dry up the riverbed. Moses said don't fear, stand still and see the Salvation of the Lord, which He will show you today. And you'll see these Egyptians no more.

He ordered Moses to lift his rod and stretch his hand over the sea to divide it as a great wall to hold the water till Israel passed. Then, He hardened the Egyptians hearts to follow. The Angel of God, who was Jesus, per 1 Cor. 10:1-4, went from before Israel, and moved behind them. The pillar of the cloud left their faces and turned black to hide Israel from Pharoah and his army. Moses lifted his hand and Jesus made the sea go back by a strong wind to make a shield to cause the sea to dry up over night. The rest is history. When Pharoah and his army were all on the dry seabed, Jesus released the water and destroyed them all.

The "Red Sea" is our death bed. Our last chance to <u>rest</u> in Jesus to lead us to the <u>Promised</u> Land. We hear His call, but our nature resists. Read Hebrews 4:9 "There remains a Sabbath Rest for God's people." Vs. 4:11 says, "Let's be diligent to enter that Rest, so none of us follow Israel's example of disobedience." Vs. 3:12 says they had evil unbelieving hearts that (in Heb. 3:16-19) provoked Jesus. They couldn't "see" Him in the star and cloud, and trusted Moses instead (John 5:39-47 & Duet. 18-19). Jesus swore they wouldn't enter His rest because of their <u>unbelief</u>. Heb: 4:13-14 reveals that He sees the thoughts and intentions of our hearts and minds and judges whether we're resting in Him, or not! Certain death is our "Red Sea." It's now, or never time-- to rest 100% in Jesus to hold back Satan's flaming arrows of doubt until we safely reach the other side. He's faithful forever! 






## THE LAST WORD

...from Pastor Jason

"Boldness"

In Ephesians 6:19-20, after exhorting us to first put on the full armor of God, Paul prays for something that we all need to seek…boldness in speaking of the gospel.

19...for me, that utterance may be given to me, that I may open my mouth **boldly** to make known the mystery of the gospel, for which I am an ambassador in chains, that in it I may speak **boldly**, as I ought to speak.

In these, the closing days of time, we need now more than ever, more than any time in our lives, or in anytime of the history of the world to not be "ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God that brings salvation to everyone who believes" (Romans 1:16). We need to be willing to be inconvenienced from "our lives" and willing to give up our very lives (and I am not just talking about lifestyle here) in order to tell the Truth to all in earshot about our LORD and Savior.

Though we live in times where it seems that fewer and fewer will "endure sound doctrine" (2 Tim 4:3) we need to press on for the cause of Christ. For we are not even near experiencing the persecutions that Paul endured, or contending with the same thorn in his side, or facing a certain death sentence as he was, and yet we who have been and remain free, remain silent too often. The only chains on most of us are those burdens that we have attached to our own mouths out of fear of retribution.

May we realize that we too are ambassadors of Christ and we too "ought to" realize the great opportunity and responsibility that Christ has given us to do NOW. May we be obedient and experience what the early church did in Acts 4:33 - "With great power the apostles continued to testify to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus. And God's grace was so powerfully at work in them all". I pray that the Chain breaker and Way maker will cause His Holy Spirit to fall fresh on us and give us His boldness to do His will.
