Losing Our First Love

October 2025

Revelation 2:4

A warning to the church of Ephesus to renew her first love for God. Paul wrote in Eph. 3:1-9 of God's Grace given him by revelation, revealing the mystery of Christ, not known for generations, now revealed by His apostles in the <u>Spirit</u>. Specifically, Gentiles are now fellow heirs; members of the body, and partakers of the promise and unfathomable riches "in Christ," thru the Gospel. Ephesians 3:13-19 says, for <u>this</u> reason, Paul prayed for God to grant us the power, by faith in Christ's Spirit within us, to comprehend the total dimension of His Love for us so we may be filled with <u>all</u> of God's <u>fullness!</u>

Eph.1:4 says God chose us <u>in Christ</u> before the foundation of the world to be holy and blameless before Him! Hebrews 10:10-17 fulfilled this, saying we <u>have</u> been sanctified by the offering of Jesus' body once for all. He <u>has perfected</u> for <u>all</u> time those who <u>are</u> sanctified and remembers <u>their</u> sins no more as Heb. 9:12 and 28 recorded. In Mark 3:28-29 and John 16:7-9 Jesus said the Holy Spirit, when He comes, will convict us that every sin <u>will</u> be forgiven, but unbelief in Him. Hebrews 3:12-4:11 says Israel's <u>evil</u> sin (unbelief in Him-1 Cor. 10:1-4) stood between her and the Promised Land. Heb. 4:12-13 says <u>nothing</u> is hidden from Jesus, the word of God. He sees if we're resting in Him today! Hebrews 10:26-29 says to go on sinning, in unbelief, tramples under foot the blood of Jesus that sanctified us. It insults His Spirit of Grace and leaves us with the eternal sin and God's consuming fire.

Eph. 1:5-7 says by His <u>Grace</u>, God chose us "<u>in Christ</u>," foreknowing we would believe "in Him" (per John 6:64) to be adopted as sons thru Jesus blood redemption; lavished on us by the <u>kind</u> intention of <u>His</u> will. Vs's 1:13-14 says our destiny is fulfilled "In Christ" after listening to the message of <u>truth</u>, the <u>Gospel</u> of our salvation– having also <u>believed</u>, we're sealed in Him with the Holy Spirit, given as a <u>pledge</u> (promise) of our inheritance, to the view of God's <u>possession</u> to praise <u>His</u> glory! The Gospel of 1 Cor. 15:1-6 says Christ died for our (flesh) sins. Then was buried and raised on the third day. He revealed Himself to over 500 people at one time, proving there can be resurrected life for us, with Him, after death. Romans 8:2 says there's <u>no</u> condemnation for those who are <u>in Christ</u> and 8:8-11and 8:37-39 promise that the same Spirit that raised Jesus will raise us from the dead, and <u>nothing</u> can be found in all creation that can separate us from the <u>Love</u> of God, in Christ!

Eph. 2:1-10 says we all once lived in the lusts of our flesh as children of wrath. But God, rich in mercy, and great love for us, even when dead in our sins, made us alive with Christ and raised us up with Him, and seated us with Him in the Heavenly Places "in Christ." Note carefully- God sees future tense, now, as present tense in His eyes. We're to claim this, also, as our set eternal position with God thru trust "in Christ." It applies to all the "in Christ" promises. Eph. 2:8-10 says we're saved by faith in His Grace. Even our faith is a gift from God! Hebrews 12:2 says fix our eyes on Jesus, the Author and Perfecter of our faith. Eph. 3:21 says to God be the glory in the church, and in Christ, to all generations forever. Ephesians 4:30-32 tells us not to grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom we were sealed for the day of redemption. Let bitterness, wrath, anger, clamor, malice and slander be put away. Be kind to one another, forgiving each other, just as God "IN CHRIST has forgiven us!

1 John 4:10 and 17-18 say "This is love, that God sent His Son to be the satisfaction for our sins. His Love is perfected with us, so we may have <u>confidence</u> in the day of judgment." "There is <u>no</u> fear in Love; but (His) Perfect Love casts out fear, because fear involves punishment" - that Jesus satisfied in Vs. 10. Our first Love (honeymoon) may be over but the Holy Spirit thru 1 John 4:19 reminds us that "We love God because He first Loved us in Him!" -dbenna710@gmail.com







Participants must take a pledge to remain clean and sober and recommit to it yearly as well as attend church and youth activities to stay eligible. This program was pioneered and first implemented and financially supported by the Caring Christians Sunday School Class in the 1980s and has helped to keep many teens drug, tobacco, and alc ohol-free during their formative years. The program was adopted by the Ad Council in 2017 to continue to positively influence the lives of our teens.

We get to spend a little time with folks we haven't seen for awhile returned to the stadiums and churches for a quick visit. As pleasant as these brief reunions are, this has me thinking about the "big homecoming" that all believers should be looking forward to one day. That Homegoing to our heavenly Father. Hebrews 13:14-16 (NLT) reminds us:
